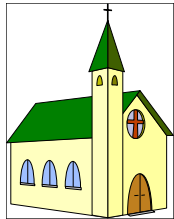

What's a "Love is Patient" Youth Conference?

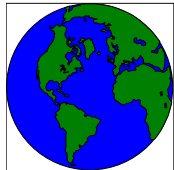
